**DECISION OF THE
LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD**

**IN RE: SHEILA R. MOSBY
NO. P040060186**

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by Sheila R. Mosby, Permit No. P040060186, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated January 8, 2015, in which a \$250 civil penalty was imposed for Ms. Mosby's failure to timely submit a federal tax clearance.

It is unclear from the record whether Ms. Mosby was in fact delinquent in the payment of her federal taxes. She testified regarding a payment plan in conjunction with her bankruptcy. This calls into question the accuracy of the tax delinquency notices from the IRS. At the time of the hearing, the IRS had granted a tax clearance to Ms. Mosby.

We will remand this matter to the Hearing Officer to allow the introduction of evidence by either party to refute or support the allegation that Ms. Mosby was delinquent in the payment of her federal taxes thirty days after the receipt of the tax delinquency notice from the Louisiana State Police, Gaming Enforcement Division. The Hearing Officer will consider any new evidence and render a decision accordingly. Either party may then appeal.


