

**JOINT MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF COMPROMISE AND
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING OFFICER:

NOW COME the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Lee Clark, Inc. d/b/a Weegee's Tavern (hereinafter, "Weegee's"), who file this Joint Motion for Approval of Compromise and Settlement Agreement, and in support thereof would respectively show unto the Hearing Officer as follows:

1.

The Division and Weegee's are desirous of settling all disputes between them relative to the referenced administrative proceeding. In connection therewith, the parties have entered into a Compromise and Settlement Agreement, which by its terms will become effective upon approval by the Administrative Hearing Office and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

A true and correct copy of the proposed Compromise and Settlement Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference for all purposes.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Weegee's, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties.


6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if the Hearing Officer approves this proposed settlement, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

7. If approved, Weegee's agrees to make full payment of the civil penalty to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Weegee's agrees that failure to meet this requirement shall result in immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action, until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.

COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Lee Clark, Inc. d/b/a Weegee's Tavern (hereinafter, "Weegee's") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Revocation to Weegee's, which Notice contains allegations of certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Revocation has been set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Weegee's are desirous of fully and finally settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Revocation;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. Weegee's is a Type 1 licensed establishment located at 2908 Jefferson Highway, Jefferson, Louisiana 70121.

2. On February 2, 2015, the Division mailed a Video Gaming Advisory Notice to Weegee's informing them of the requirement and deadline date of June 30, 2015, to submit the annual licensee form, appropriate fee and required documents.

3. On January 12, 2016, Weegee's submitted the required documents and annual fee to the Division.

4. Weegee's failed to timely submit the required annual fee and supporting documents, a violation of LAC 42:XL2405(B)(4)(a) and (b).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. In lieu of Administrative Action of its Gaming License, Weegee's will pay a civil penalty of SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY AND NO/100 (\$750.00) DOLLARS for its violation of LAC 42:XL2405(B)(4)(a) and (b).

2. The Division hereby agrees to accept Weegee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Revocation for Weegee's violation of LAC 42:XL2405(B)(4)(a) and (b).


3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this admitted violation in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of Weegee's suitability.

4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Division and Weegee's respectfully request that this Honorable Administrative Hearing Officer approve the parties' Compromise and Settlement Agreement.
