
ORDER



**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

1. the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "Division"), represented by the undersigned Assistant Attorney General, and
2. Jeshon, Inc. d/b/a Coffee & (herein "licensee"),

who respectfully enter the following stipulations into the record:

WHEREAS:

1. On October 19, 2004, TFC. Alexander Simmons conducted an on site inspection at the licensee's establishment;
2. Upon his arrival, there was no designated representative present at the licensee's establishment. However, one did arrive after he began his inspection. Further, none of the persons present had access to a locked office.
3. Based on the inspection, Division issued a Notice of Violation to the licensee on December 2, 2004, citing violation of L.A.C. 42:XI.2407(A)(1) and L.A.C. 42:XI.2407(B)(3); and
4. This matter is scheduled for hearing on January 24, 2004 at 9:30 a.m. before the Honorable Joseph E. Anzalone.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing Stipulations and the particular facts and circumstances of this matter, the Division and the licensee hereby propose the following settlement:

1. The licensee acknowledges that these actions constitute violations of L.A.C. 42:XL2407(A)(1);
2. The licensee shall pay a civil penalty in sum of **TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00)**;
3. The Division shall accept the payment of the above penalty as full and final settlement of Violation No. 13722;
4. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
5. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
6. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the licensee to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
7. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, the applicant must pay the above civil penalty to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval; and
8. The Division and the applicant waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.




IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, that the foregoing proposed settlement be approved, to-wit:

2. The licensee shall pay a civil penalty in sum of **TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00)**;


