

**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

1. the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "Division"), represented by the undersigned Assistant Attorney General, and
2. Big Easy Travel Plaza (herein "licensee"),

who respectfully enter the following stipulations into the record:

WHEREAS:

1. On March 31, 2005, S/T. Raymond V. Scott conducted an on site inspection at the licensee's establishment;
2. During the process of investigating the license renewal application, the Division determined that on March 1, 2002, Kurt B. Maloney and Carol A. Maloney were married. Additionally, Julie Maloney Wenck and Bruce William Wenck divorced on October 29, 2001. The Division was not notified of the changes.
3. The Division issued a Notice of Violation to the licensee on March 31, 2005, citing violation of L.A.C. 42:XI.2411(A)(9); and
4. This matter is scheduled for hearing on June 21, 2005 at 9:00 a.m. before the Honorable William H. Brown.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing Stipulations and the particular facts and circumstances of this matter, the Division and the licensee hereby propose the following settlement:

1. The licensee acknowledges that these inactions constitute violations of L.A.C. 42:XI.2411(A)(9);
2. The licensee shall pay a civil penalty in the sum of FIVE HUNDRED (\$500) DOLLARS;
3. The Division shall accept the payment of the above penalty as full and final settlement of Violation No. 00014606;
4. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
5. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
6. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the licensee to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
7. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer, if approved however, the applicant must pay the above civil penalty to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval; and
8. The Division and the applicant waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.


