Minutes of September 16, 2008

The meeting was called to order at 10 a.m. in the Senate Hearing Room A, State Capital. Present were H. Charles Gaudin, Chairman; Marcia Morgan, William Lastrapes, Major Claude Mercer, Velma Rogers, Claryce Minor and Ayres Bradford.

Donna Jackson, State Police Gaming Audit Division, presented the revenue reports for the riverboats, landbased casino and slots at the track. Janice Adolph, also with the Gaming Audit Division, presented the statistics for video poker.

A compliance report was given by Mesa Brown, Asst. Attorney General.

The Board was advised by Michael Tyler, Asst. Attorney General, that finalized ABS Inspection Guidelines would be presented at the Board's October meeting.

Reese Middleton gave an update on the state's compulsive and problem gambling programs.
